Easter: Celebration Of Life In A New Way

इस्टर नवजीवनाचा सोहळा

The temporary darkness that envelops the congregation gathered to celebrate the Easter Vigil is dispelled by the power of **ONE** candle. This is no ordinary candle. The Pascal candle lit from the Easter fire has the ability to illuminate the entire church and banish the darkness of our sins already redeemed by our Lord's supreme sacrifice. The flame from this one candle is shared and diffused throughout the faithful until hundreds of reflections of that light bathe the entire church in a warm glow. All this is a manifestation of the power of the resurrected Christ to cast out the darkness of our lives.



It is part of human weakness to despair and lose our way in the dark. On a personal level, a catastrophe can knock us off our feet like serious illness, accident or a bereavement. At the family level, we can engage in destructive behaviour because of feelings of ill-will and ego. At the community level, we can make impulsive decisions that endanger our long-term well-being in society.

A small boy who was consistently late coming home from school. His parents warned him one day that he must be home on time, but nevertheless he arrived later than ever. His mother met him at the door and said nothing.

At dinner that night, the boy looked at his plate. There was a slice of bread and a glass of water. He looked at his father's full plate and then at his father, but his father remained silent. The boy was crushed.

The father waited for the full impact to sink in, then quietly took the boy's plate and placed it in front of himself. He took his own plate of meat and potatoes, put it in front of the boy, and smiled at his son. When that boy grew to be a man, he said, "All my life I've known what God is like by what my father did that night."

पारुकाच्या एका मेणबत्तीने पारुकाचा विधी साजरा करण्यास जमलेल्या लोकांच्या जीवनातील तात्पुरता अंधःकार नाहीसा होतो. ही सर्व साधारण मेणबत्ती नाही. इस्टरच्या अश्रितून पेटविलेली एक मेणबत्ती संपूर्ण चर्च प्रज्वलित करू शकते आणि ख्रिस्ताच्या त्यागामुळे पापाच्या अंधःकारातून आपल्याला

मुक्त करू शकते. ह्या एका मेणबत्तीने प्रज्वलीत केलेल्या अनेक मेणबत्त्या संपूर्ण चर्च प्रकाशमय करतात. ही मेणबत्ती आपल्या जीवनातील पापांचा अंधःकार नाहीसा करण्यासाठी पुनरुत्थित ख्रिस्ताने प्रकट केलेली शक्ती आहे.

पापात पडणे व पापात वाट चुकणे हा मानवी कमकुवतपणाचा भाग आहे. वैयक्तिकरित्या एखादा आजार दुर्घटना किंवा व्यसन आपल्या जीवनाची मोठी उलथापालथ करू शकते. कौटुंबिक पातळीवर आपल्या अहंकारामुळे आपण आक्रमक होऊ शकतो. सामाजिक पातळीवर आपले चुकीचे निर्णय समाजासाठी धोकादायक करू शकतात.

एक लहान मुलगा नेहमी नियमितपणे शाळेतून उशिरा घरी येत असे. त्याच्या पालकांनी त्याला एकदा घरी वेळेवर येण्याची ताकीद दिली. तरीसुद्धा तो नेहमीप्रमाणे उशिरा येऊ लागला. त्याची आई त्याला दरवाजाजवळ भेटली; परंतु एक शब्दही बोलली नाही, रात्रीच्या जेवण्याच्या वेळी मुलाने त्याचा प्लेटकडे पाहिले तर त्यात फक्त एक पावाचा तुकडा व एक ग्लास पाणी होते. त्याने त्याच्या वडिलांची अग्नाने भरलेली प्लेट पाहिली त्यानंतर आपल्या वडिलांकडे पाहिले व तो थक्क झाला. त्याच्या वडिलांनी मुलाच्या प्रतिक्रियेची वाट पाहिली व हळूच आपली प्लेट मुलासमोर ठेऊन त्याची प्लेट आपल्याकडे घेतली आणि आपल्या मुलाला स्मित हास्य दिले. जेव्हा तो मुलगा मोठा झाला तेव्हा तो म्हणाला त्या रात्री माझ्या वडिलांच्या त्या एका कृतीमुळे देव कोण आहे ह्याची मला जाणीव, प्रचीती आली.

Easter - resurrection of Jesus



Sportspersons warm up before a match to prepare themselves to face its challenges. So too, we need warming during these 40 days of Lent to prepare ourselves spiritually for Easter. During this period we engage in three spiritual exercises; prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Five Sundays of Lent help us in soul. Searching and taking stock. The liturgy and the word of God on these five Sundays reveal the true spirit of the Lenten Season to faithful seekers.

On Good Friday, the disciples were deeply and bitterly disappointed when Christ was crucified. They had hoped that Jesus was the one to set them free. Today, our governance is in shambles. The state of security is in tatters. Health and poverty alleviation schemes are in bad shape. Violence against women, rapes, scams, vandalism, targeted attack on our Churches in Delhi and other parts of India. Religious right wing accusing Christians of forced conversions, RSS chief Mohan Bhagwat ascribed motive to Mother Teresas' work, saying that her agenda was conversion.

All our dreams are in pieces. Darkness looms over the nation especially the Christians with no ray of hope in sight. Christ demonstrated by this life on earth that the 'death resurrection journey' is the only way of living the sacrificial love of God that is essential to the Easter Story of Christ's New and Eternal life. He is alive not just after death, but here and now, Christ is everywhere. The disciples found him in the breaking

of the bread. He appeared to them and said, "Wherever two or three are gathered in my name, I am there in thier midst and also said that I am with you always, even to the end of the world."

With the risen Lord, we confront sickness, despair and come through that valley of darkness. We follow Christ himself in this pilgrimage from death to life, confident that god opens the way before us. Dying and rising are an integral part of undying love of Christ that we are committed to in order to stand on the side of justice, mercy and peace. The season of lent is time for us to open our hearts and allow Lord to transform our life.

Love is the eye, which enables us see and understand the resurrection. That is why, after the resurrection some saw Jesus but others did not, some understood the resurrection while others did not. Those with the eyes of faith saw and understood. Those without the eyes of love either didn't see anything or were perplexed or upset by what they did see.

Christ is risen, though we might not see Him! Whether we see or not and what precisely we do see depends mainly in what's going on inside our own hearts. For Jesus' broken body will sanctify and blood will wash us clean of all our sinfulness on Good Friday. This in turn will illumine and transform our old selves into new selves. Lent leads us to fulfillment and culmination in the resurrection of Jesus on Easter Day.

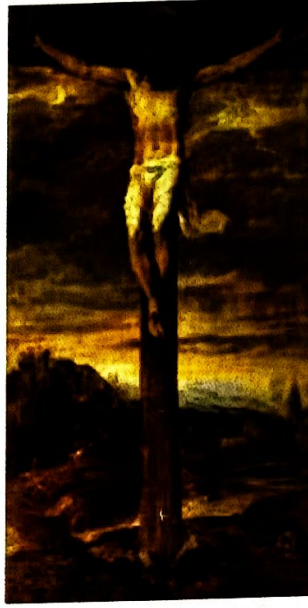

“बापा त्यांना क्षमा कर”

प्रजाकसत्ताकदिनाचे प्रमुख पाहुणे मनसोक्त उपभोगून झाल्यानंतर (अमेरिकेचे अध्यक्ष बराक ओबामा) यांनी जगातील ‘धार्मिक असहिष्णुतेवर’ जी टीका केली होती, तिचा संदर्भ साहजिकच भारताशी जोडला गेला. भारतातील सध्याचे एकूण वातावरण लक्षात घेता असे होणे स्वाभाविकही होते.

समाजात ज्या कोणाविषयी कोणत्या ना कोणत्या तऱ्हेच्या संशयाचे बीज पेरत राहणे हा काही व्यक्तींच्या व संघटनांच्या कार्यक्रम पत्रिकेचाच एक भाग आहे. त्यातून गांधी, टिळक, नौरोजी आणि मौलाना सुद्धा सुटले नाहीत. त्याही पलीकडे ज्यांच्या विषयी असा संशय पेरायचा ती माणसे परधर्माची असली की हे बीजारोपण आणखी सोपे होते. ख्रिश्चन मिशनऱ्यांचे व त्यांचे संत यांच्याविषयी विटंबना करणे सहज जमणारे आहे आणि संघाच्या कार्यक्रम पत्रिकेचा तो एक मुख्य भाग आहे. इंदिरा गांधीचा खून करणाऱ्या



गुन्हेगारांचा गौरव अमृतसरच्या सुवर्ण मंदिरात पार पडला. तसेच गांधीजींचा खून करणाऱ्या गोडसेविषयी गुणगान केले. काही वर्षांपूर्वी ओडिशाच्या अरण्य प्रदेशातील कुष्ठरुग्णांची सेवा करणाऱ्या ब्रॅह्म स्टेनला त्याच्या दोन मुलांसह मोटारीत कोंडून जिवंत जाळणाऱ्याचा ‘धर्मवीर’ म्हणून ‘गौरव’ केला. काही दिवसापूर्वी कॉन्व्हेंट च्या ७१ वर्षांच्या नन वर ‘गॅंगरेप’ करण्यात आला त्यांचा ही ते गौरव करण्यात कदाचीत मागे पुढे करणार नाहीत यात काय शंका?

कलकत्याच्या झोपडपट्यांमधल्या गरिबांची सेवा करण्यासाठी मद्र तेरेसा यांना ‘मिशनरी ऑफ चॅरिटी’ ही संस्था स्थापन केली. त्यांनी कामाचा आवाका, व्याप वाढत आंतरराष्ट्रीय स्तरावरही संस्था नेली. सुरवातीच्या अवघड परिस्थितीतून वाट काढत, अनेक बहुमान मिळवत मद्र तेरेसा यांनी आपल्या सेवा व्रताची वीण घट्ट केली. १९६२ साली भारत सरकारने त्यांना ‘पद्मश्री’ बहाल केली. त्याच वर्षी त्यांना ‘मॅगसेसे’ हा पुरस्कारही मिळाला. १९७९ मध्ये शांततेचा नोबेल पुरस्कार मिळाला आणि १९८० साली मद्र तेरेसांना भारताचे सर्वोच्च बहुमान ‘भारतरत्न’ मिळाला. ५ सप्टेंबर १९९७ रोजी हृदयविकाराच्या झटक्याने वयाच्या ८७ वर्षी त्यांचे देहावसन झाले. एक समर्पित आयुष्य अनंतात विलीन झाले. अनेक कुष्ठरोगी, एड्सग्रस्त, दीनदुबळे अशा लोकांच्या सर्वांथाने माय ठरलेल्या मद्र तेरेसाचा हा जीवनप्रवास नक्कीच स्तिमित करतो. त्यांनी देवाच्या आज्ञेसाठी आपला देश आपली माणसे, आपली भाषा, आपल्या आवडी-निवडी, आपला पोशाख, आपली माणसे, आपले व्यक्तिमत्त्व यांचा त्याग करून परकी बोली, व परकी माणसे त्यांच्या पोशाखासकट आपलीशी केली.

व्हॅटिकनच्या धर्मपीठाने जिला संतत्त्व प्रदान केले आणि देशाने जिचा ‘भारतरत्न’ या सर्वोच्च नागरी सन्मानाने गौरव केला त्या

सेवामूर्ती मद्र तेरेसावर छुप्या पध्दतीने धर्मांतर घडवून आणल्याचा राष्ट्रीय संगम संघ्याच्या श्री. मोहन भागवतांनी केलेला आरोप म्हणजे भारतरत्न सन्मानाचा घोर अपमान होय. भारत हे हिंदू राष्ट्र आहे हे व त्यांचे विधान मान्य नसणारे इतर धर्मीय सारेच त्यांच्यामते धर्मद्वोही व देशद्वोही आहेत. भागवत व संघ या दोघांचीही मानसिकता त्या प्रकारची आहे. मात्र सेवाधर्माचे अनुकरण करणे, त्यासाठी अरण्यप्रदेशात राहून, जेथे कुणी जाणार नाही अशाही ठिकाणी पोहचून आदिवासींची व वंचितांची खरी मनापासून सेवा करणे त्यांना मात्र काहीजमले नाही म्हणून त्यांच्या मनात या सेवाधर्मी माणसांविषयी नेहमीच एक विषाक्त असूया राहिली आहे.

मद्र तेरेसांविषयी कोलकत्ता शहरात व बंगाल मध्येच नव्हे तर सान्यादेशात श्रद्धेची व प्रेमाची भावना आहे. त्यांच्या निर्वल सेवाकार्याचा गौरव सर्वत्र आदरभावाने केला जातो. श्री. भागवतांनी मात्र मद्रचा हा सेवाभाव खरा नसून तो त्यांच्या धर्मप्रसाराच्या कार्याचा भाग होता असे मद्रच्या मृत्यूनंतर १७ वर्षांनी सांगून त्यांच्याविषयी अनादर भावना उत्पन्न करणाऱ्या अनर्थ प्रयत्न केला आहे. मद्र तेरेसा यांच्या कामाविषयी जाण असणाऱ्यांनी श्री. भागवतांचा तत्काळजगभरातून निषेधही केला. त्यांच्या सेवाभावाने भारावून जाऊन एखाद्याने बर त्यांचा धर्म स्वीकारला असेल तर त्याला त्यांनी विरोध केला नाही. पण धर्म प्रचाराची सक्ती करण्याची किंवा जाणीवपूर्वक कोणाचे धर्मांतर घडवून आणण्याचे धार्मिक पापही त्यांच्या हातून कधी घडले नाही. हेही एक सत्यच आहे. कारण त्यांचे कार्य लोकांच्या साक्षीने व जनतेच्या डोळ्यांसमोर झाले.

२०१४ च्या निवडणुकीत भाजपाला सत्ता मिळाल्यापासून दिल्लीतील ख्रिश्चनांच्या श्रद्धास्थानावरचे हल्ले वाढले. श्री. भागवतांच्या तेरेसावरील टीकेनंतर कर्नाटकातील मंगलोर परिसरातल्या चर्चेंसवर हल्ले झाले. या आधी एकट्या ओडिसामध्ये १२०० पुजास्थाने जाळून भस्मसात करण्याचा लोण झाला. हे डांग परिसरात झाले, कर्नाटकात झाले आणि गुजरातेत त्याचा कहर झाला. अशामुळे सामाजिक एकोप्याला तडे जाऊन व त्यातूनच राष्ट्रीय एकात्मतेची भावना दुबळी होते.

वस्तुतः भारताच्या १२५ कोटी लोकसंख्येत एक-दोन टक्काही ख्रिश्चन नाहीत. त्यामुळे ते धर्मांतराची मोहीम राबवतील आणि सर्व भारत ख्रिश्चन बनवतील या प्रचाराला वस्तुस्थितीचा सुतकाम आधार नाही, तसं काही दर्शवत नाही. तरीही हा भयगंड पसरवला जातो. तेव्हा तो केवळ कडवी धर्मवादी मनोभूमिका आकाराला आणण्याचा आणि भारतातील बहुसांस्कृतिकता वर्हिद्धधर्मातील सर्वसमावेशकता कायमची संपवून टाकण्याच्या दूरगामी उद्दिष्टाचा एक भाग असतो. हे लक्षात ठेवायला हवं.

माझ्या अखिरस्ती बंधू भगिनींनो, तुम्ही ख्रिश्चन शाळेत, कॉलेजमध्ये शिक्षण घेतलं. काय आहे तुमचा अनुभव? धर्मांतराची सक्ती तुम्ही कधी अनुभवली आहे का? नसेल तर का नाही तुम्ही आवाज उठवता आणि जबाब देता त्या श्री. भागवंताला? हिंमत दाखवा व ख्रिश्चन शाळा - कॉलेजात शिक्षण घेतलेल्या कृतज्ञतेने सामोरे जा त्या श्री. भागवंताकडे. हीच माझी कळकळीची विनंती सर्व भारतीय अखिरस्ती बंधू भगिनींना ज्यांनी ख्रिश्चन शाळा कॉलेजांचा, मध्ये सरस्वती देवीची आराधना करून सत्य भावनेशी स्वतःला समरूप केले. उपयोग करून घेतला आहे त्यांना.

संत लुईस मंदिरातील उपवास काळातील घडामोडी - (कार्यक्रम)

उपवास काळ म्हणजे परमेश्वराच्या जवळ येण्याचा काळ. उपवास, दानधर्म व प्रार्थना करण्याचा काळ. आंतरिक शुद्धीकरणाचा काळ होय.

आपण परमेश्वराच्या अधिकाधिक जवळ कसे जाऊ शकतो? त्याचा अनुभव आपण कसा घेऊ शकतो? तर तो केवळ दररोजच्या मिरसेद्वारे व प्रभूशब्दाद्वारेच हे घडू शकते.

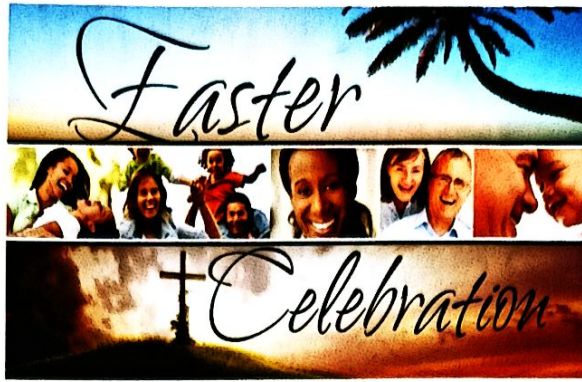

The temporary darkness that envelops the congregation gathered to celebrate the Easter Vigil is dispelled by the power of **ONE** candle. This is no ordinary candle. The Pascal candle lit from the Easter fire has the ability to illuminate the entire church and banish the darkness of our sins already redeemed by our Lord's supreme sacrifice. The flame from this one candle is shared and diffused throughout the faithful until hundreds of reflections of that light bathe the entire church in a warm glow. All this is a manifestation of the power of the resurrected Christ to cast out the darkness of our lives.



It is part of human weakness to despair and lose our way in the dark. On a personal level, a catastrophe can knock us off our feet like serious illness, accident or a bereavement. At the family level, we can engage in destructive behaviour because of feelings of ill-will and ego. A young wife had become gravely ill, then suddenly passed away, leaving the big man alone with a wide-eyed, flaxen-haired girl, not quite five years old. The man brought his daughter's little bed into his room so they could face the emptiness of first dark night together. As the minutes slipped by that night, the young girl was having a dreadful time trying to sleep...and so was her father. What could pierce a man's heart deeper than a child sobbing for a mother who would never come back? After a while, the little girl managed to stop crying—but only out of sorrow for her father. Thinking his daughter was asleep, the father looked up and said brokenly, "I trust You, Father, but...it's dark as midnight" Hearing her dad's prayer, the little girl began to cry again. "I thought you were asleep, baby," he said. "Papa, I can't even see you, it's so dark." Then, through her tears, the little girl whispered, "But you love me, even if it's dark—don't you, Papa? Enlightened by the words of the girl, the man prayed "Father, it's dark as midnight. I can't see You at all, but You love me, even when it's dark and I can't see, don't You?" From the blackest of hours, the Lord touched him with new strength, enabling him to carry on.

Where do we find the guidance to help us get back on track when darkness takes over? For many people struggling with darkness in their lives, associations such as SCC, Prayer Groups, St. Vincent de Paul Society, Legion of Mary, Youth Group, Ladies of Sodality and such other selfless associations of our parish

animated by their faith could be the light that acts as a beacon of hope. Like the power of one candle, may these associations shine and dispel the darkness in another's life and be the light at the end of the tunnel. And, taken together, all of those candles have the power to bathe our communities in the warm glow of compassion that leads to opportunity for every fellow

human being. A helping hand, a kind word, a necessary resource shared can be the spark that provides light where before there was none.

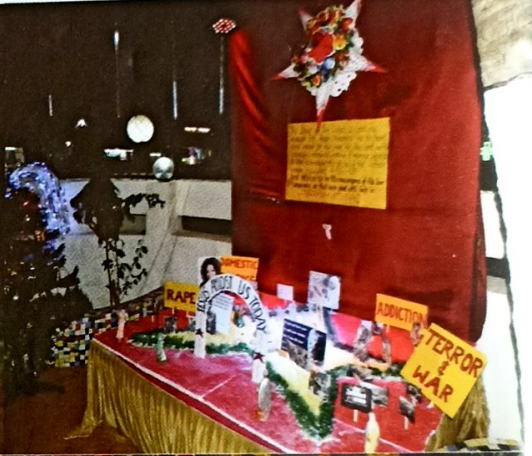
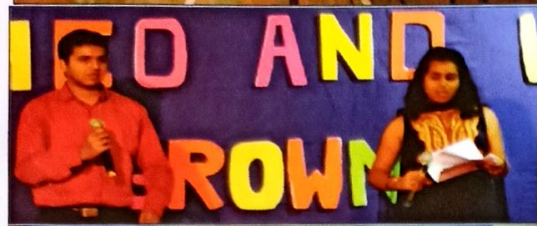
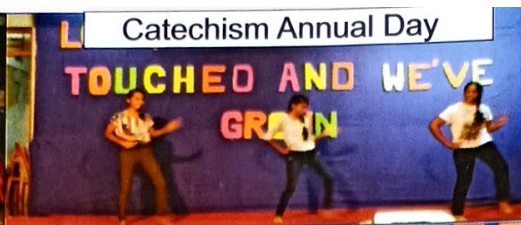

January

Faith formation: Students of Std VII and VIII had faith formation on the 8th at St. Anne's School, Borivli. Various projects were taken up by different parishes. Our parish presented the project on "Bonded labour". Thanks to the catechists for their support and guidance.

Session for lay heads and asst. heads of associations and

cells: The III Extraordinary General Synodal Assembly, which will take place in Rome in October 2015, came out with the Lineamenta on the family. This questionnaire was filled by all the heads and asst heads of associations and cells on the 22nd. Three groups were formed; each group was animated by the OLCM members Mrs. Christine Thomas, Mr. Thomas Theknath and Mrs. Jacinta Vales.

March

Recollection: On the 1st a recollection service was organised by the SVP members for the adopted families.

Sunday school annual day: The Sunday school children put up a cultural programme with skits and dances based on topics from their syllabus. Certificates were also given to them.

Retreat: On the 8th and 9th a retreat was organised by the English Charismatic Prayer group of our parish from 5.30 pm to 9.30 pm Fr. Allwyn Misquitta, SDB, conducted the way of the cross, rosary and celebrated the Eucharist. Br. Mario Joseph from Divine Retreat Centre, Potta, enlightened us on family values, citing on his own personal testimonies and stressed on giving God a prominent place in our lives by devoting more time in prayer. Confirmation: 42 students received the sacrament of confirmation by Bishop John Rodrigues on the 15th at the 8.30 am mass. The liturgy was well prepared and organised systematically by the catechists.

Recollection for Eucharistic Ministers: A recollection service was organised by the archdiocese for the Borivli and Bhayander deaneries at St. Pius seminary on the 15th. Seven of us attended the session. Fr. Gavin, a professor from the seminary, spoke on the role of Eucharistic Ministers in the church. He said that the purpose of the Eucharistic Minister was not merely to administer Holy Communion in the church and to take it to the sick and homebound, but also to carry the passion and love of Jesus to them by showing our love and concern towards them. The recollection concluded with an adoration service, followed by the answering of queries by Fr. Barthol Barreto from I.C. Church.
