# Lent prepares us to Rejoice with the Risen Lord


Lent, comes from the Middle English word *lenten*, meaning springtime - the time of lengthening days, is a period of forty days of fasting, prayer, and penitence before Easter. There is biblical support for doing penance, but the season of Lent, like all Catholic liturgical seasons, developed over time.

Saint Teresa of Lisueux used to say: "The reason for my confidence is God's justice. Being just, HE is bound to take into account the fact that I am weak." St. Francis de Sales, whose gentleness, refinement and wisdom enriched so many in his life time, has this touching expression; "I would prefer to be judged by God than by my own mother." This is one of the opportunities for us to see the weaker side of our human life. As Jesus shed tears in the garden of Gethsemane as he was trying to discern

the will of the Father, we too are called to see what is God's will in each our lives.

Do you believe that you are precious for God - more precious than you are for your own father and mother? This is the Good News - the incredible good news! "The time is fulfilled; God is near Repent; believe in the Good News", this is how Jesus started His preaching. Lent is a special time to capture - and be captured by this good news. It is not a gloomy period of doing without happiness in our faces. It has the flavour of the meaningful self-discipline an athlete accepts to prepare for an important sports meet, not the sadness of a loveless home. Since we are Easter people, let us be joyful in this preparation to receive our Risen Lord.

We were taught as children to "give up something" for this season of Lent. The sacrifices in Lent are really penance, in the same spirit as the Ninehvites that repented at the preaching of Jonah. Throughout our history, Christians have found prayer, fasting, and almsgiving to be an important part of repentance and renewal. Many Christians now add something during Lent rather than giving up something, either to address personal habits that need to be worked out or to add some outreach to others in need. It is not necessary to "give up something" but it would be a tragedy to do nothing. It would be like saving our fasting money to give to the poor. It could be making peace



with someone with whom we have some problems. Or to start a daily prayer life either personal or family if we are not doing it in our lives.

Our beloved Cardinal invites us to look into some of the aspects of our lives in this season of Lent. He states that in the Archdiocese of Bombay the faithful may observe the days of common practice of penance by choosing from any one of the following:

- 1. Making the Way of the Cross or a visit to the Blessed Sacrament or a Meditation on the Lord's Passion.
- 2. Prayerfully reading the Scriptures or Praying the Liturgy of the Hours
- 3. Preparing for Liturgical Services by reflecting on the readings as a family.
- 4. Giving 10% of one's daily wage in charity.
- 5. Donating Blood.
- 6. Offering voluntary service to a Social / Charitable Institution through some parish association.
- 7. Offering a meal to a poor family.
- 8. Abstaining from meat preparations if meat is part of one's regular diet.
- 9. Missing any one meal: breakfast, lunch or supper.
- 10. Taking strictly vegetarian meals, without even fish and eggs.
- Abstaining all beverages like tea or coffee or sweet drinks between meals.
- 12. Avoiding films, television and other forms of recreation.

Can we make this experience of Lent as a personal experience which will help us to experience the Risen Lord in our lives? Let us encounter him personally in our prayer life, penance and alms giving. May the Risen Lord continue to bless all of you and your families.

### **Gospel Sharing**

Seven Step Method

(Can be used in any of the church meetings or family meetings of 5 to 15 members.)

Instructions: Choose a quiet place. Sit in a circle. Appoint on animator if necessary. Choose a relevant Bible passage in advance. Time taken 10-15 minutes, excluding Step. 6

#### Step 1: Invite the presence of the Lord.

The invitatory prayer can be based on scripture promises, e.g. Mt. 18:20, Lk. 10:38-42, Lk. 24:29-32. The animator does not appoint somebody to pray, but ask people to come forward voluntarily to pray inviting the presence of the Lord.

#### Step 2: Read the relevant Bible passage.

One member of the group reads it aloud, slowly and clearly; the others listen / read silently. Repeat the same by another member.

# Step 3 : Pick out word(s), phrase (s), verse(s) and meditate on them.

Select word(s), phrase(s), verse(s) which strike us most and read them aloud prayerfully and slowly 3 times. Any number of members can do this one after another, while others are meditating on the same. Even a very "insignificant" word, repeated prayerfully aloud, can help the members of the group attain deep union with Christ.

#### Step 4 : Let God speak to us in silence.

Remain silent for about three minutes and allow God to speak to us. Meditate on the word(s), phrase(s), verse(s) which touched us most.

#### Step 5: Share what we have heard in our hearts.

Which word(s), phrase(s), verse(s) touched us personally? Give reasons (brief). Any number of members can do this one after another.

DON'T Give a message for the group (sermon). Use the pronoun "I" to share not "we"

DON'T expound on a point of theology (doctrine).

DON'T be pulled into controversial issues.

DON'T try to give the entire meaning of the passage.

DON'T disagree with the person's sharing.

DON'T start an argument about the correct interpretation of the passage.

DON'T bombard the person with a whole lot of advice.

# Step 6: Discuss any task which our group is called to do. We have created an atmosphere of mutual trust and have

We have created an atmosphere of mutual trust and have accepted the Lord in our midst. In this spiritual climate, problems can be discussed and action plans made.

#### Step 7: Pray together spontaneously.

All are invited to pray spontaneously. All that we have done in our Gospel sharing and what we have discussed about our task can flow into our spontaneous prayers. We can end with a prayer / hymn which all know by heart.

#### **Faith Celebration**

24th January has left a lasting impact on our lives as we, the children of std VII and VIII went for faith formation on this day to St. Anne's School. We were entrusted with the topic 'Pilgrimage'

The quest for knowledge of pilgrimage started from the 1st week of September. This hard work continued till the end of January.

We began this quest with a trip to Bandra during the Mount Mary's feast. Our main aim to go for this trip was to enlighten ourselves about the legends of these churches and to know what is meant by a pilgrimage. Then on 14th November 09 we came together for a recollection where on the characteristics of pilgrimage places and pilgrimage experiences were explained. Slides on the trip to the Holy Land undertakes by some of our parishioners and priests were also shown to us.

On 28th Nov. 09 we learnt about a pilgrimage through Bible passages. We were shown a movie on the Acts of the Apostles in which the apostles experienced a pilgrimage with the coming of the Holy Spirit in the form of tongues of fire. The disciples went about fearlessly teaching, healing and doing the work Jesus did. Later on we went in procession by holding candles and singing hymns to I.C. Church. A recollection service was held. All these sessions and trips enlightened us a lot and we also became aware of the advantages and

importance of a pilgrimage.

We had to prepare charts, skits and powerpoint presentations, to converse and to bring about our topic and message to the other parishes in a simple way. We prepared charts on famous churches like Mount Mary Church, Shrine of Don Bosco, St. Michaels Church, Our Lady of Fatima, Our Lady of Lourdes and Immaculate Conception church. A skit was prepared on day to day life situations and ways to overcome it.

At last the day came to bring about our efforts. There were 7 parishes who were given different topics. Each one's preparation was unique and different and had a message to take home and put into practise. The topics emphasized during the faith formation were "Global Warming, Consumerism, Pilgrimage, Mass Communication and cleaning of the Mithi river. We also had a Bible quiz on the lessons covered during our catechism class. We concluded with a reflective Eucharist.

We thank our catechism teachers Mrs. Josephine and Sr. Jeena and also our parish priest for giving us the opportunity to witness this faith formation which helped us build our faith. We also thank the other volunteers without whom this wouldn't be a success.

आमची ही सोड्यिलटी संघटना चालविण्यासाठी सि. जीना व सि. प्रगती येवून पुष्कळ त्रास घेत असतात. व त्या आम्हीला नेहमी सांगत असतात की, बायांनो प्रेमाने रहा, प्रेमाने कार्य करा जे काही आहे ते इथेच सोडून जायचे आहे.

संत तेरेजा म्हणते; "देवाचा न्याय हाच माझ्या विश्वासाचा आधार आहे." संत फ्रान्सीस दी सेल्स म्हणतो; "माझा निवाडा माझ्या आईपेक्षा परमेश्वरानेच करावा." मानवी जीवनाची कमजोर वाजू पाहण्याची संधी हा उपवासकाळ आपल्याला देत असतो. ख्रिस्त म्हणतो काळाची पूर्णता झालेली आहे. परमेश्वर आपल्या पश्चात्तापयुक्त मनस्थिती जवळ आहे. उपवासकाळ आपल्याला परमेश्वराजवळ जाण्याचे साधन आहे. त्याकरिता पुनरुत्थित ख्रिस्ताचे स्तवन करुया.
