


Meet Pope Leo XIV

Pope Leo XIV was elected on 8th May, 2025, succeeding Pope Francis. Here's some interesting information about our reigning Pope.

- His name is Robert Francis Prevost. Prevost's regnal name was chosen in honor of Pope Leo XIII whose encyclical Rerum novarum established modern Catholic social teaching and promoted labour rights.
- Pope Leo XIV was born on 14th September 1955 in Chicago, USA and raised in the nearby suburb of Dolton, Illinois
- He is the first pope to have been born in the United States and North America, the first to hold American and Peruvian citizenships.
- His father is Louis Marius Prevost and mother is Mildred Agnes Prevost (née Martínez) who were both practicing Catholics & were very involved in the parish.
- In addition to his native language of English, Leo speaks Spanish, Italian, French, and Portuguese, along with some German. He can also read Latin.
- Educational background: B.S. in Mathematics, Villanova University (1977), Master's Degree in Divinity, Catholic Theological Union (1982) and Doctorate in Canon Law, Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas (1987).
- On September 1, 1977, Prevost joined the Order of Saint Augustine as a novice in the Province of Our Mother of Good Counsel.
- Prevost was ordained a priest in Rome, at the Chapel of Saint Monica of the Augustinians by Archbishop Jean Jadot on June 19, 1982
- On September 30, 2023, Late Pope Francis created Prevost a cardinal with the rank of Cardinal-Deacon and on February 6, 2025, Prevost was elevated to Cardinal Bishop.
- Based on St. Augustine's concept, Prevost sees authority as a service. He says that service means "listening to what the Spirit is saying in His people so that His projects can be carried out freely and willingly. The Prior then is called to listen, so that together they can discern and implement what the Spirit inspires."
- The new pope's first message emphasized the greeting of peace of the risen Jesus "who gave his life for God's flock", giving "an unarmed and disarming peace".

We witnessed the step-by-step efforts made to raise St. Louis Church and School, working selflessly to achieve this goal. They served generously in the Pastoral Ministry and in the field of Education.






